1836 - 1936

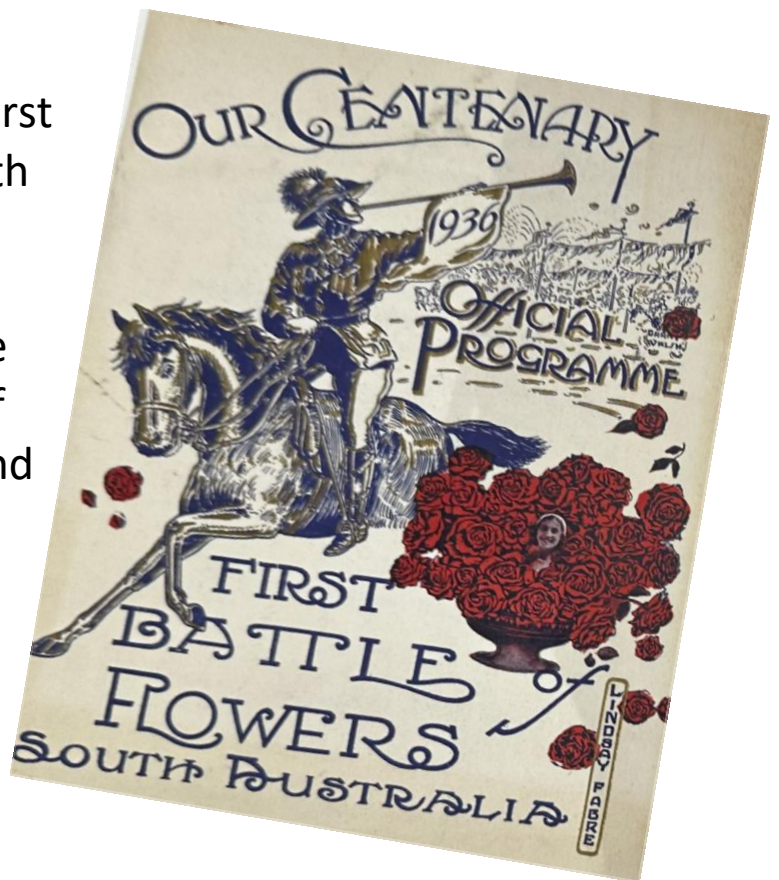
SUNDAY 18th MAY, 11am–4pm
